WHEREAS, the County of Mendocino desires to undertake a certain project designated as the Smart Prosecution – Innovative Prosecution Solutions Project to be funded through a Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.






