RE: ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION **AUTHORIZING** THE **DEPARTMENT** OF TRANSPORTATION **ADVERTISE** TO FOR BIDS AND AWARD DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT NUMBER 200055 FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION AND WIDENING OF EAST SIDE POTTER VALLEY ROAD, COUNTY ROAD 240, FROM MILEPOST 5.58 TO M.P. 6.37, AT AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$3,500,000 (POTTER VALLEY AREA)

Honorable Board Members:

The Mendocino County Department of Transportation (DOT) Contract Number (No.) 200055 will provide for the reconstruction, widening, and re-alignment of East Side Potter Valley Road. This project is to increase the safety of East Side Potter Valley Road by realigning and widening approximately 0.75 miles of this road as Phase 1.

A general contractor will be required to complete this project at an estimated cost of \$3,500,000. The project is to be funded primarily through 2021 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) funds; however since this project's inception in 2000, DOT, Mendocino Council of Governments & special Board of Supervisors General Fund, allocations of approximately \$5.13 million have already been expended.

DOT intends to advertise for bids and have this project completed this calendar year. DOT will prepare construction plans, specifications, estimates and contract documents, advertise and award a County contract, and coordinate the project with other governmental agencies.

I recommend and request that the Board authorize and direct the Director of Transportation to advertise for construction bids and award DOT Contract No. 200055 for the Reconstruction and Widening of East Side Potter Valley Road.

DOT staff personnel have prepared a draft Resolution which provides said authorization for the Board's consideration and adoption.

I will, of course, respond to any questions the Board may have.
