I whole heartedly support the temporary moratorium on Phase 3 licensing until the Cannabis and Building planning department/s are able to hire more planners to work on applications with the applicants so they are ready to successfully be reviewed and passed through Phase 1 or have distinct targets to work on to prepare for Phase 3.

I whole heartedly support the temporary moratorium on Phase 3 licensing until the community sees how this drought plays out. Perhaps we can reclaim some of the water sold to municipalities south of us so we can use our own water once more. Perhaps we can take a look at which crops and animals and activities require the most water and work to problem solve with those so we can move forward on what is, frankly, a fairly thrifty water-using plant compared to corn and many other food crops.

I whole heartedly support the temporary moratorium on Phase 3 licensing until a sane and stable pathway can be identified and solidified before moving forward that in no way penalizes any Phase 1 applicant from applying for a Phase 3 license on any location or zone where cannabis has been traditionally grown, including rangeland, but with a one acre cap per individual, partnership, LLC or corporate entity.
