

SUMMARY

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AMENDING CHAPTER 6.36 – CANNABIS FACILITIES BUSINESSES AND CHAPTER 20.243 – CANNABIS FACILITIES

This ordinance is making several updates, revisions and additions to various sections of Chapters 6.36 and 20.243 of the Mendocino County Code regarding the County's cannabis facilities business licenses and zoning requirements for cannabis facilities. Proposed amendments include the removal of church as a sensitive receptor, revisions to the manufacturing use type to allow for shared-use facilities, revisions to the retail use type to clarify existing regulations and add regulations for cannabis tourism, lodging, farm tours and farmer's markets, revisions to the zoning table for manufacturing and distributor uses, the addition and modification of definitions to better align with State regulations, and the elimination of obsolete sections.
