Hello,

It is my understanding that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors is on track to approve the use of 10% of any agriculturally zoned parcel for the farming of marijuana.

In spite of letters from concerned neighbors who rely on wells for their water supply and who have noted a decline in the water table, the Planning Department and Board of Supervisors feel that it is important to address a "cannabis" shortage.

The Board will be meeting on April 19th. Is there any recourse for regular folks who will be impacted- especially during this drought year?

Also for folks who oppose this expansion of the farming of a water thirsty "crop" that is for recreation and not sustenance?

I am firmly opposed to this expansion and wonder if the Board believes that all "regular folk" should just move out of this county so that

marijuana can be farmed without restriction.
