

Dear Mendocino County Board of Supervisors,

I sit on the board of the Sanhedrin Chapter, California Native Plant Society. Although our comments have been thoroughly addressed in a submitted letter, I wanted to point out the documented rare plant species that are found across the county. The attached spreadsheet contains a current list of these rare species queried from the California Natural Diversity Database. The goal of the CNDDB is to provide the most current information available on the state's most imperiled elements of natural diversity. The list is arranged in order of their degree of rarity or California Rare Plant Rank (CRPR), ie. "1A" being most rare, and representing those species found within Mendocino County. Glancing at the list it's apparent that many occur within habitat common to the county's lands zoned rangeland (RL), such as oak woodland, chaparral, grassland, and associated seasonal wetlands. All of the plants constituting California Rare Plant Ranks 1A - 2B and many CRPR 3 and 4 plants meet the definitions of the California Endangered Species Act of the California Fish and Game Code, and are eligible for state listing. Impacts to these species or their habitat must be analyzed during preparation of environmental documents relating to CEQA, or those considered to be functionally equivalent to CEQA, as they meet the definition of Rare or Endangered under CEQA Guidelines §15125; (c) and/or §15380.
