Please reconsider your idea to allow larger cultivation areas for cannabis in the county. There is already an obscene amount of cannabis grown here. Every year there are more grows. The quality of life has gone down and the increase in crime is appalling.

1. There is not enough water for any increase. Too many creeks dry up due to pumping. Springs are also drying up because of the extreme water usage of cannabis. I've seen Woodman creek dry up 4 times the past 10 years. Not naturally but within a week or two because water is being pumped from the creeks. I invite you to watch the frantic fish about to die from lack of water. It's not pretty.

2. Zoom in while looking at google maps of just the Woodman creek area so you can see how many hoop houses are located here. All for pot. There are hundreds. Way, way too many.

3. Too much other environmental damage, such as cutting down trees, using pesticides and chemicals, and diverting water, to name a few.

4. Part of your mission as supervisors is to deliver services that meet the environmental needs of the community. I personally am very tired of pot growers and their blatant disregard for all laws.

More cannabis cultivation is NOT good for the environment.
