WHEREAS, high-quality early learning and care services have been shown to be a valuable investment in our children's future, and in the future of our county; and

WHEREAS, family child care homes, private child care centers, tribal centers, subsidized child care centers, expanded learning/after school professionals, have continued to provide services during the Covid-19 global pandemic, addressing health and safety concerns and finding fiscal solutions to the challenges of operating during the pandemic; and
