WHEREAS, Resource Families play an important role in making sure children and adolescents, who are not able to remain with their birth parents, are able to grow and develop in a safe, stable and nurturing environment until they can be reunified with their families or achieve permanency; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino County has over 200 children in foster care; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino County is experiencing a shortage of local resource families, even more so during the COVID-19 pandemic, and is in need of families willing to care for children of all ages, but especially teens, children with complex behavioral and mental health needs, and siblings; and

WHEREAS, Foster Care Awareness Month is celebrated nationally to raise awareness of the need for and value of foster care as a temporary, last resort service that provides help, safety, healing and hope to children and adolescents and their families; and

WHEREAS, during National Foster Care Month, we celebrate all those who have invited a child in need into their hearts and homes, and express our profound appreciation for all who help ensure the safety, permanency and well-being of children.
