REQUEST: Consider proposed adoption of Mendocino County Code Chapter 22.18 - Commercial Cannabis Activity Land Use Development Ordinance and corresponding proposed amendments to Mendocino County Code Chapter 10A.17 - Mendocino Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance, and Chapter 20.242 - Cannabis Cultivation Sites. Chapter 22.18 establishes a discretionary permitting process for cannabis cultivation activities. Corresponding changes to Chapter 10A.17 and Chapter 20.242 are proposed as well to avoid conflicting and/or overlapping regulations.

PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION: The Planning Commission, at their May 6, 2021 meeting, adopted a resolution making a further recommendation to the Board of Supervisors that they adopt an ordinance amending Mendocino County Code, Title 22, to add Chapter 22.18 creating a new discretionary cannabis cultivation permitting system and amending Chapters 10A.17 and 20.242 of the Mendocino County Code to remove Phase 3 of the previous permitting system, with modifications made at the meeting and as specified in their resolution.
