As a member of the Robinson Creek Road Fire Safe Council, we have been working diligently to decrease the fuel load in our one lane in/one lane out road, which Cal Fire considers to be one of the most dangerous road systems for emergency exits during a fire event.

The MCFSC's help in obtaining grant funds to assist communities like ours to be as safe as possible has been **INVALUABLE**. To even consider reducing their funding at this time when we are experiencing a severe drought year with heavily laden forests of dead and dying trees would be a tragic mistake!
