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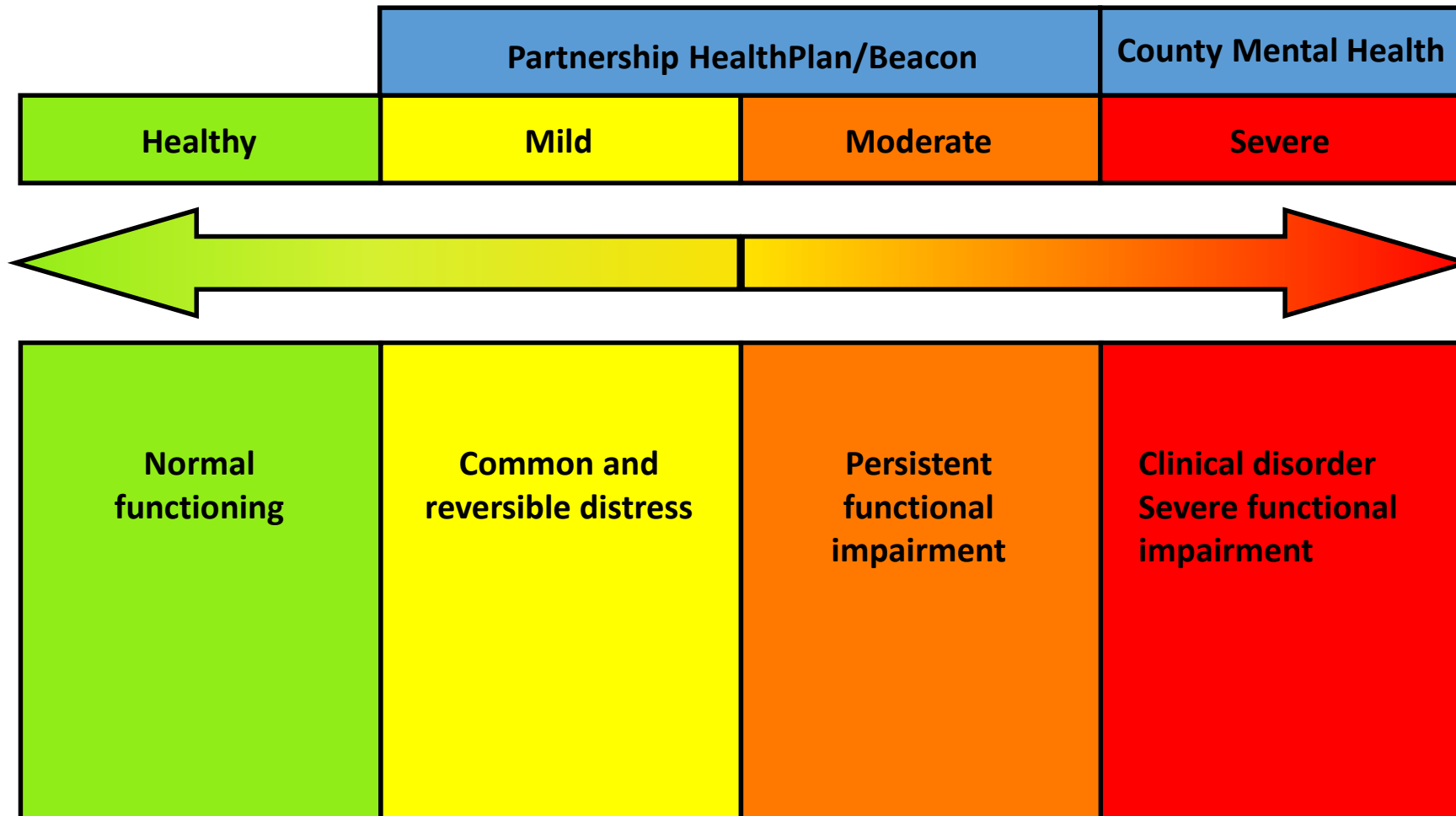

Specialty Mental Health Services

- **The County Mental Health Plan provides, arranges, and pays for all medically necessary covered Specialty Mental Health Services to:**
 - Medi-Cal Beneficiaries
 - Who also meet Medical Necessity Criteria for Specialty Mental Health Services
- **County Mental Health Plan Audit, Review, and Oversight**
 - Department of Health Care Services – Triennial
 - Mental Health Services Act – Triennial
 - External Quality Review Organization – Annually
 - Fiscal Cost Reports - Annually

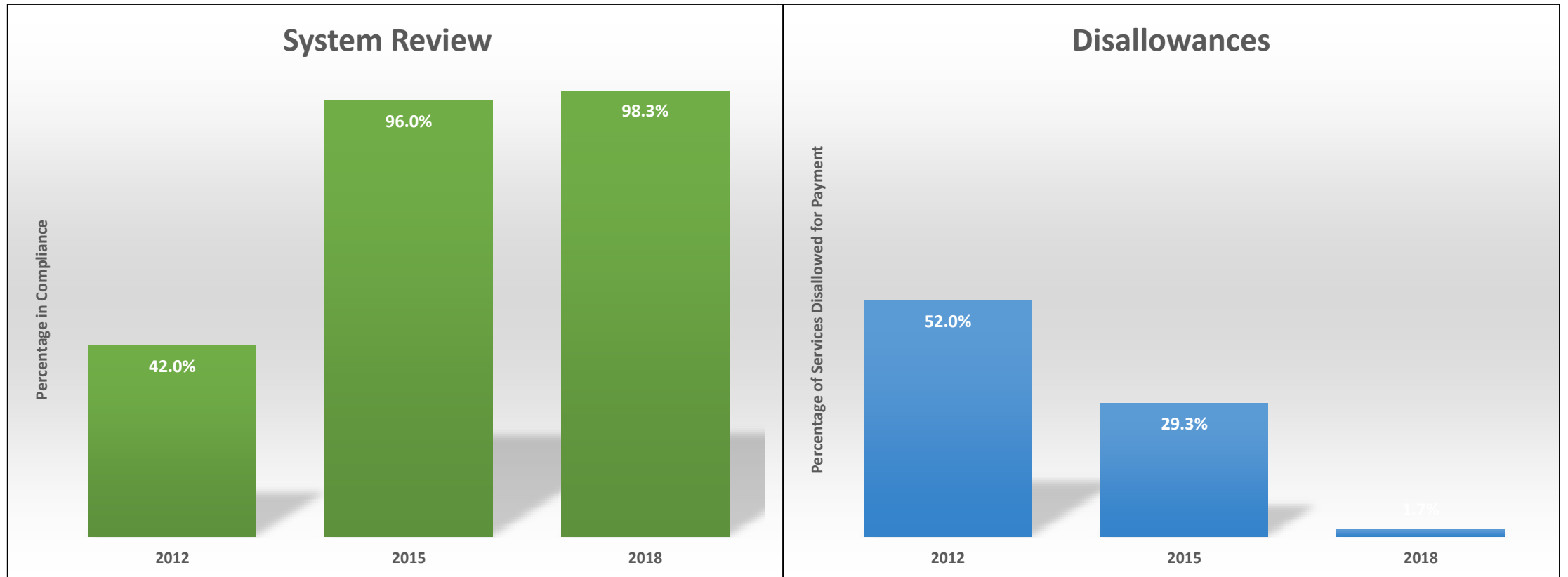
- Coordination with County and Community Partners as the Administrative Service Organization (children/transitional age youth since 2013; all clients as of 2016)

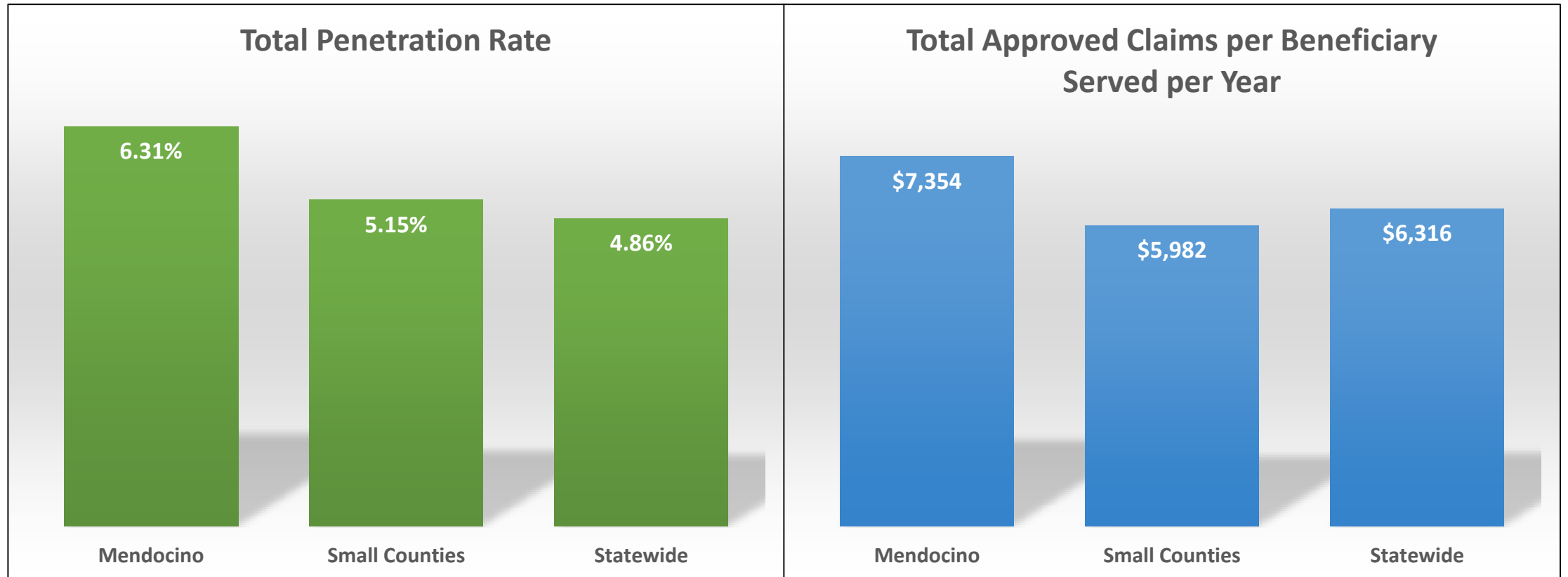

Department of Health Care Services – System & Billing Review



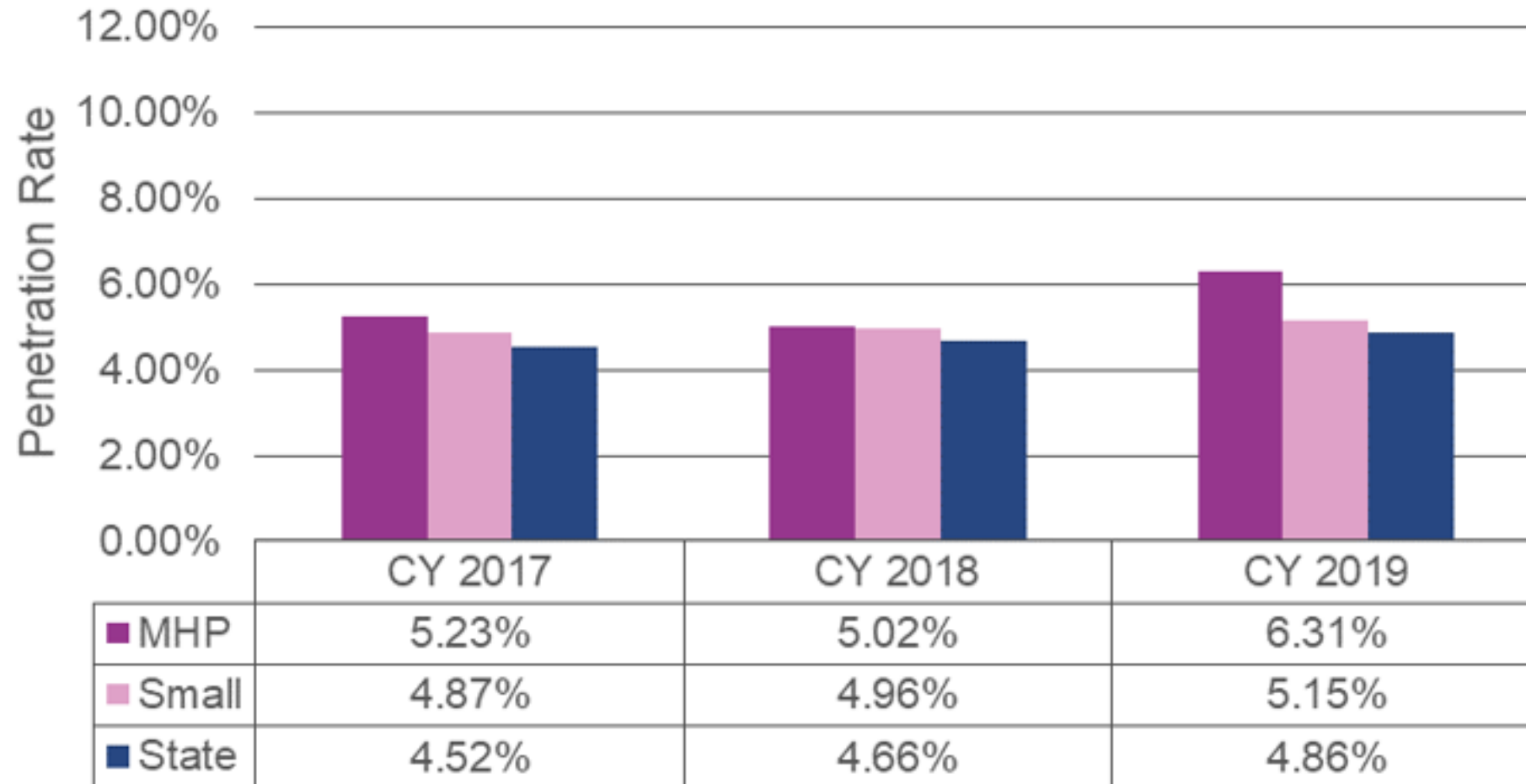

Penetration Rate / Approved Claims - Calendar Year 2019



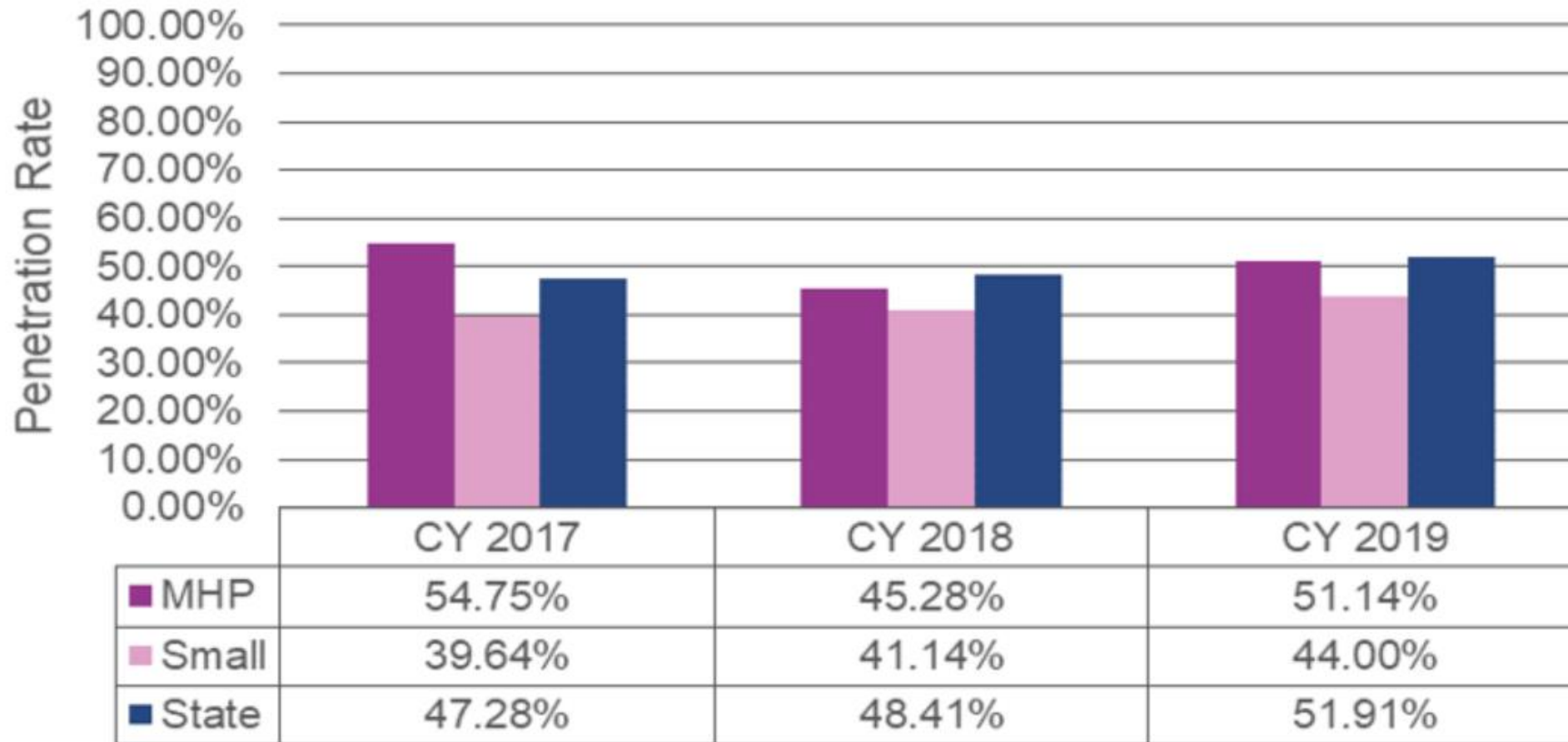

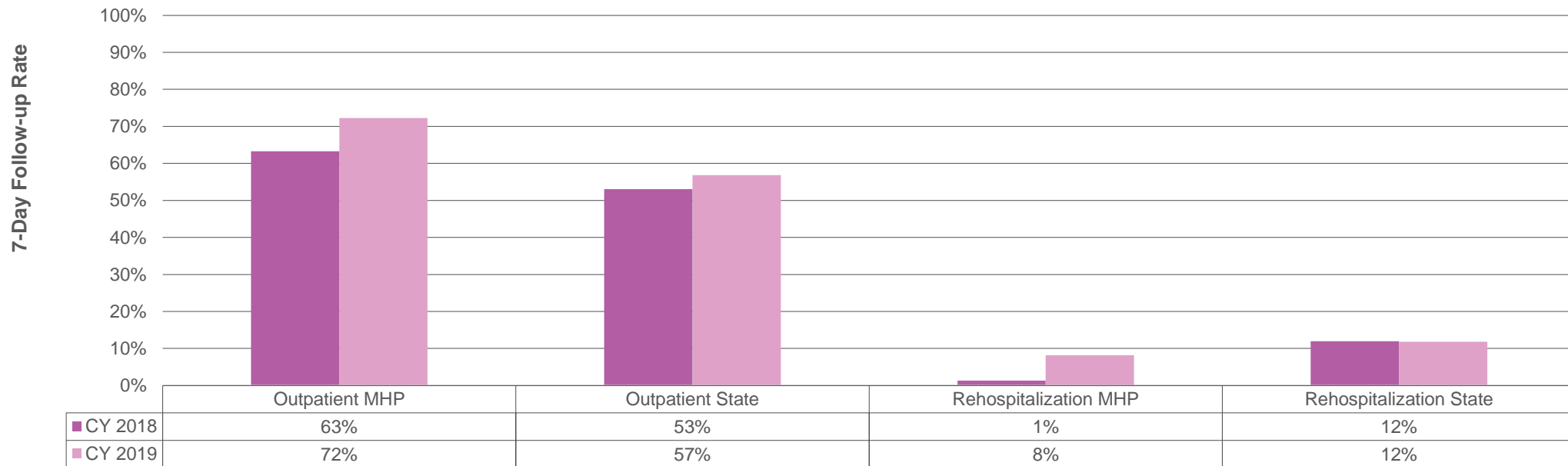
Foster Care Penetration Rates: 2017 - 2019

Post-Psychiatric Inpatient 7-Day Follow-Up and Re-hospitalization

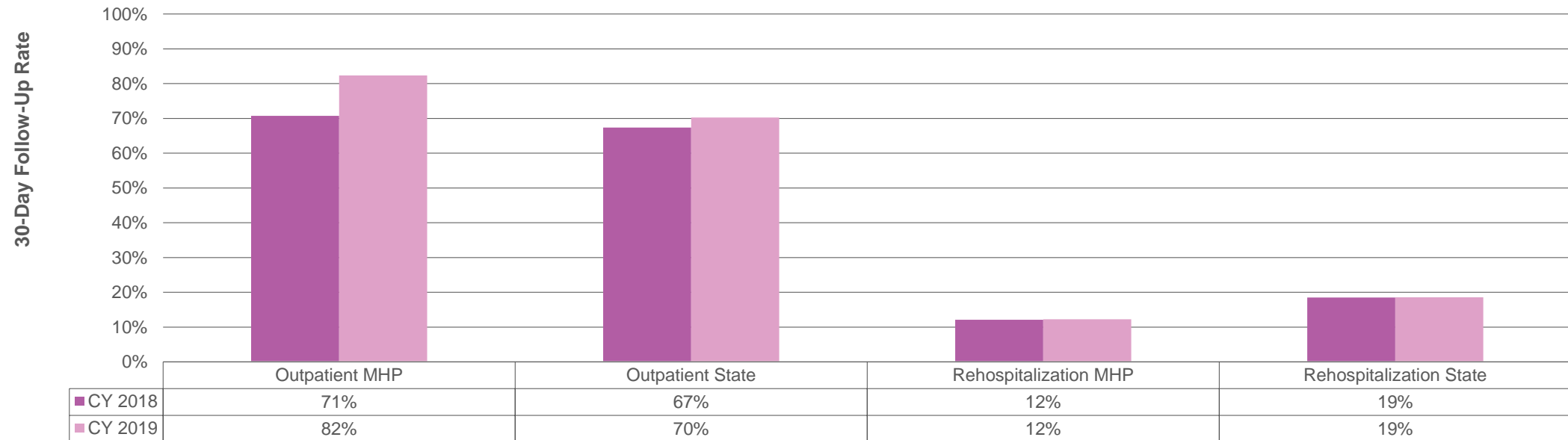

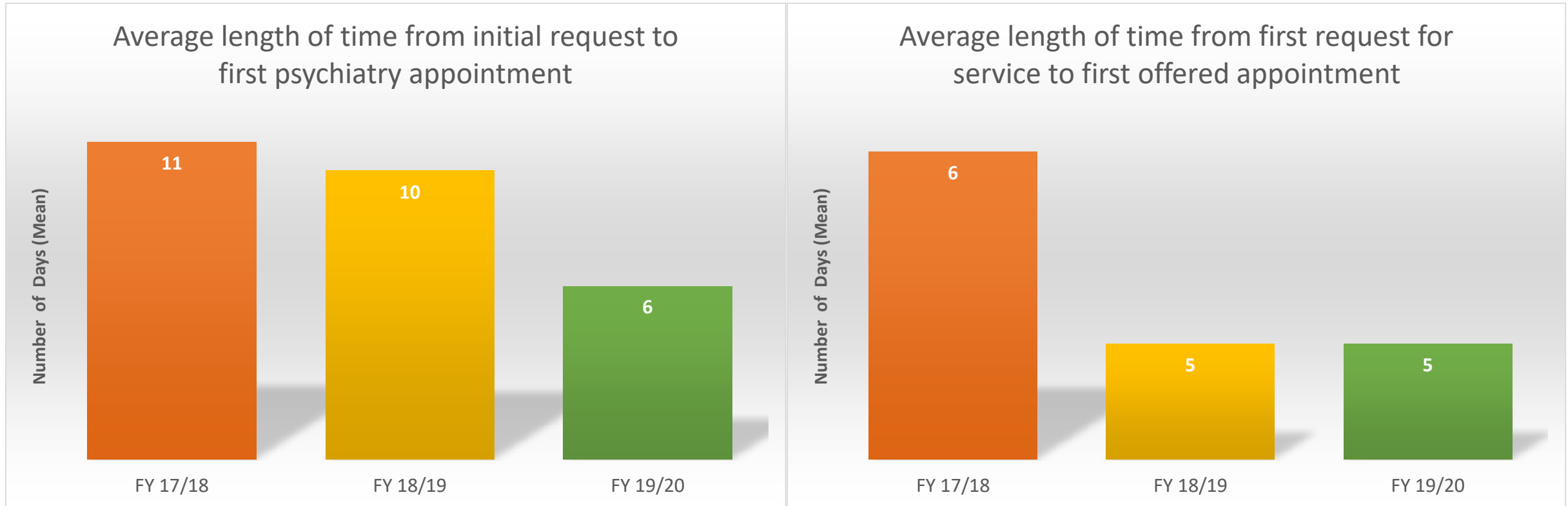
Post-Psychiatric Inpatient 30-Day Follow-Up and Re-hospitalization

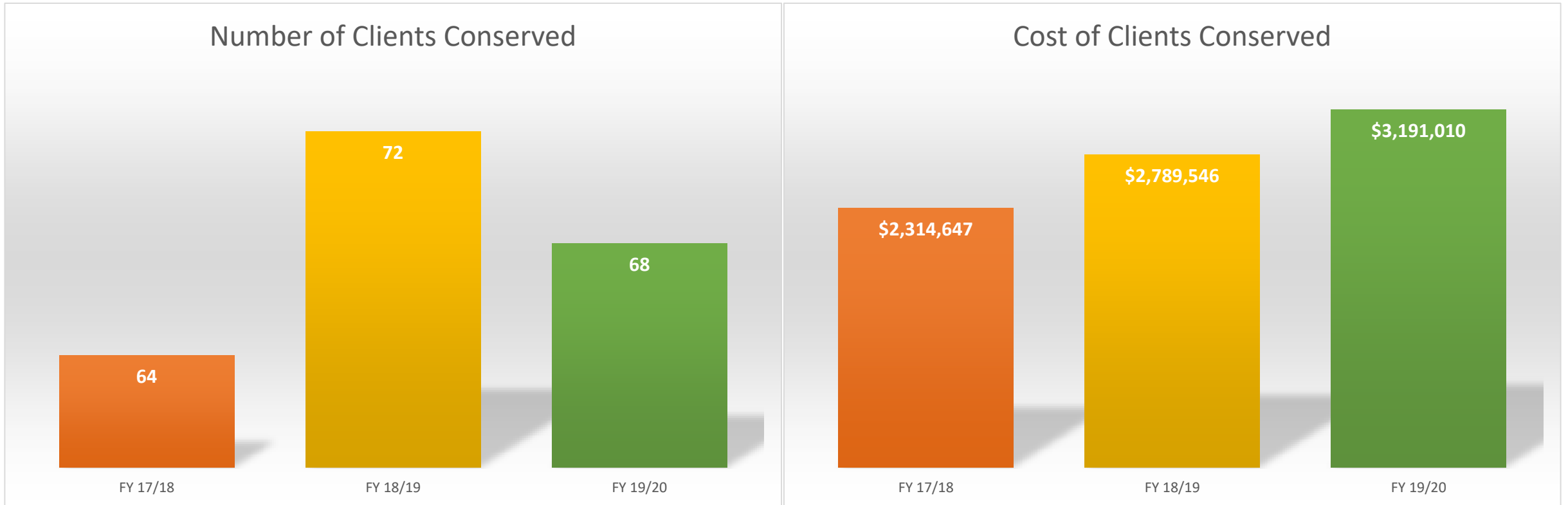

Mendocino County Timeliness Data



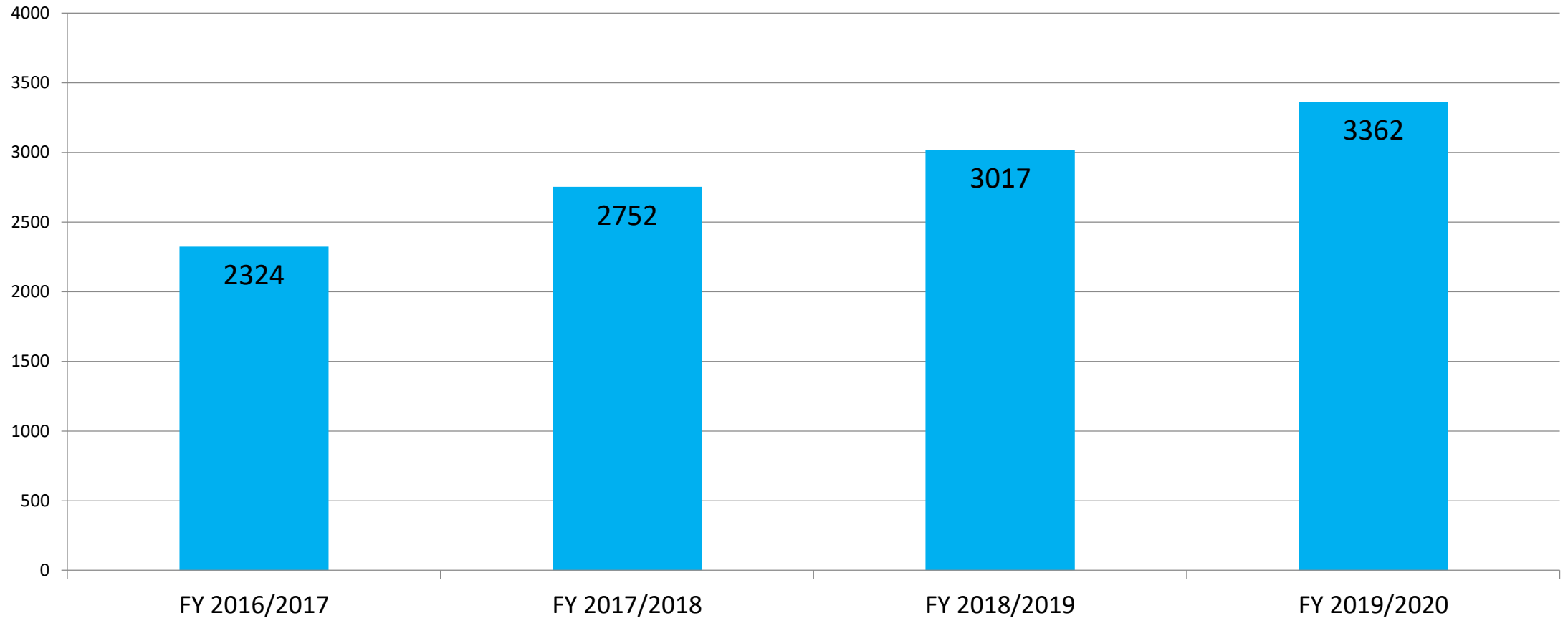

Mendocino County Conserved Client Data



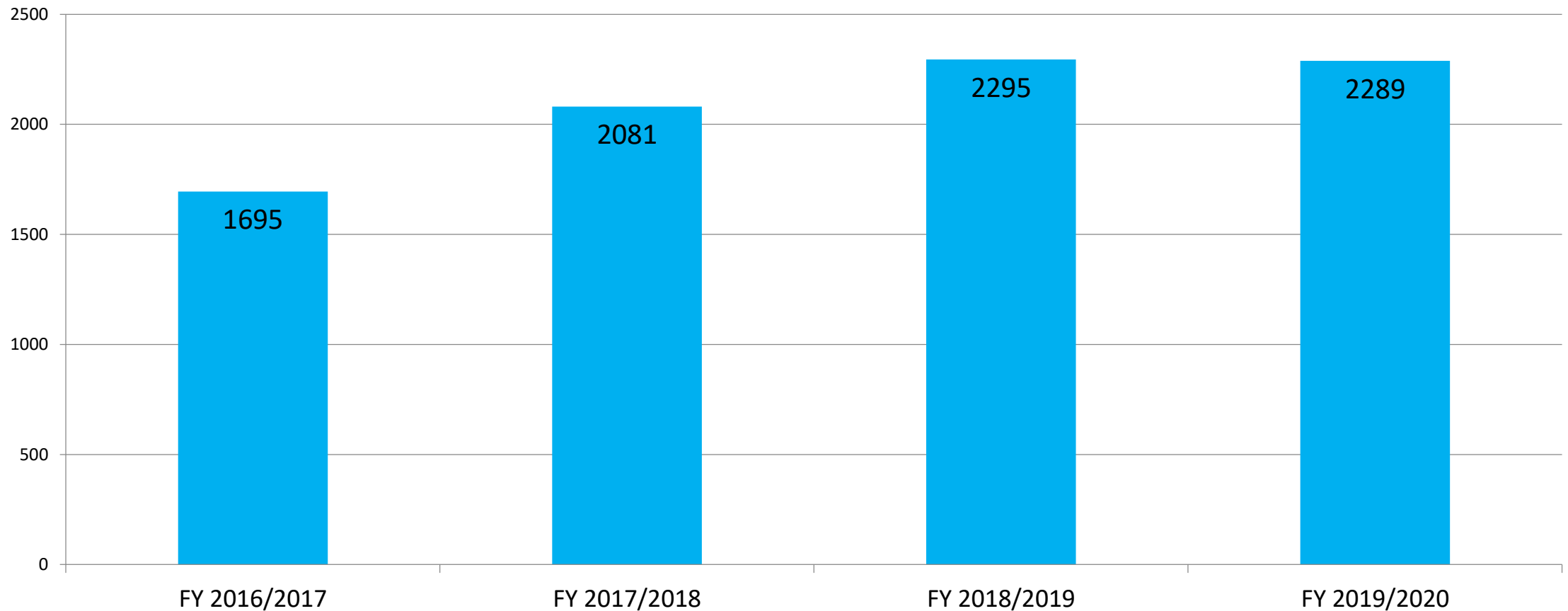
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Unduplicated Persons Served by the Mental Health Plan



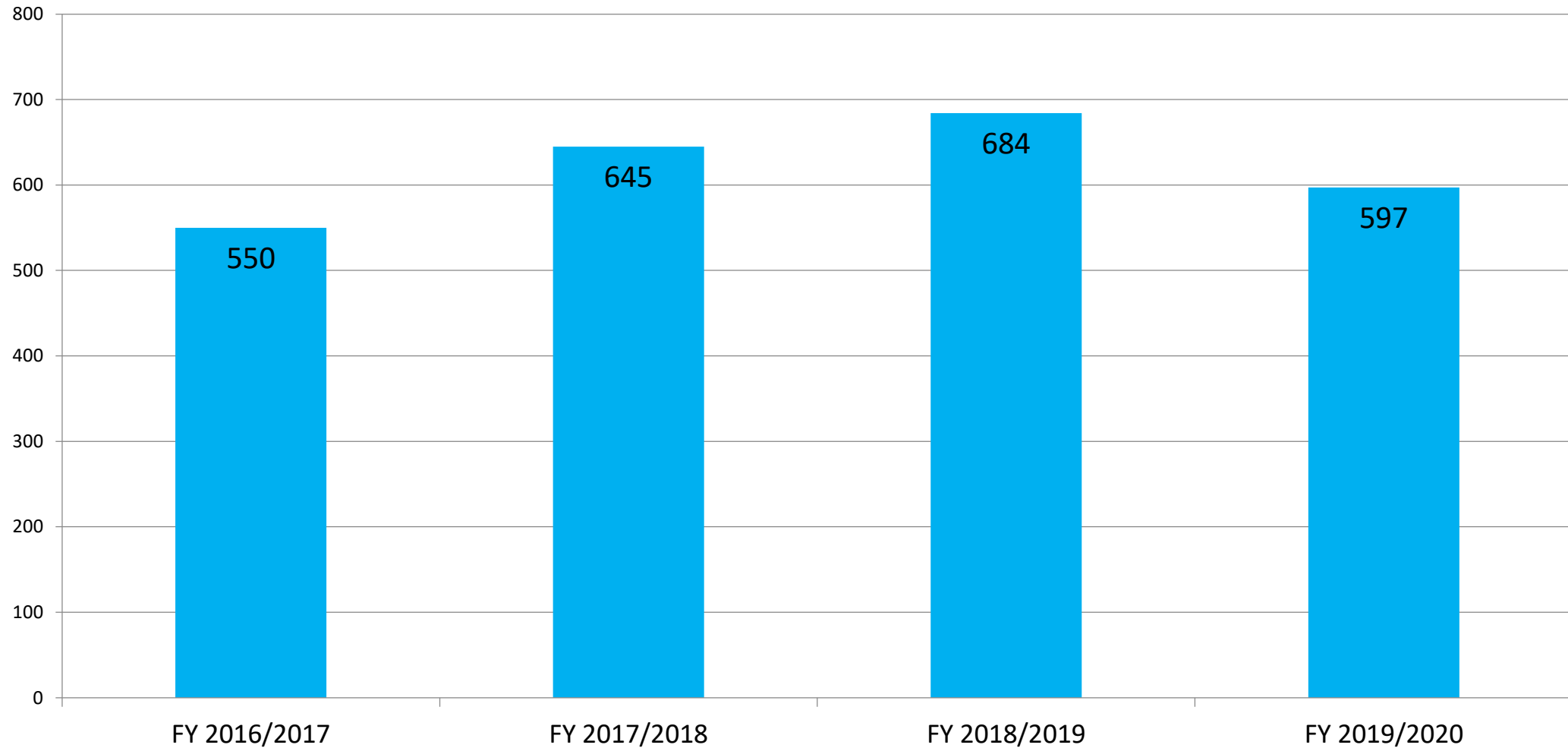
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Crisis Assessments



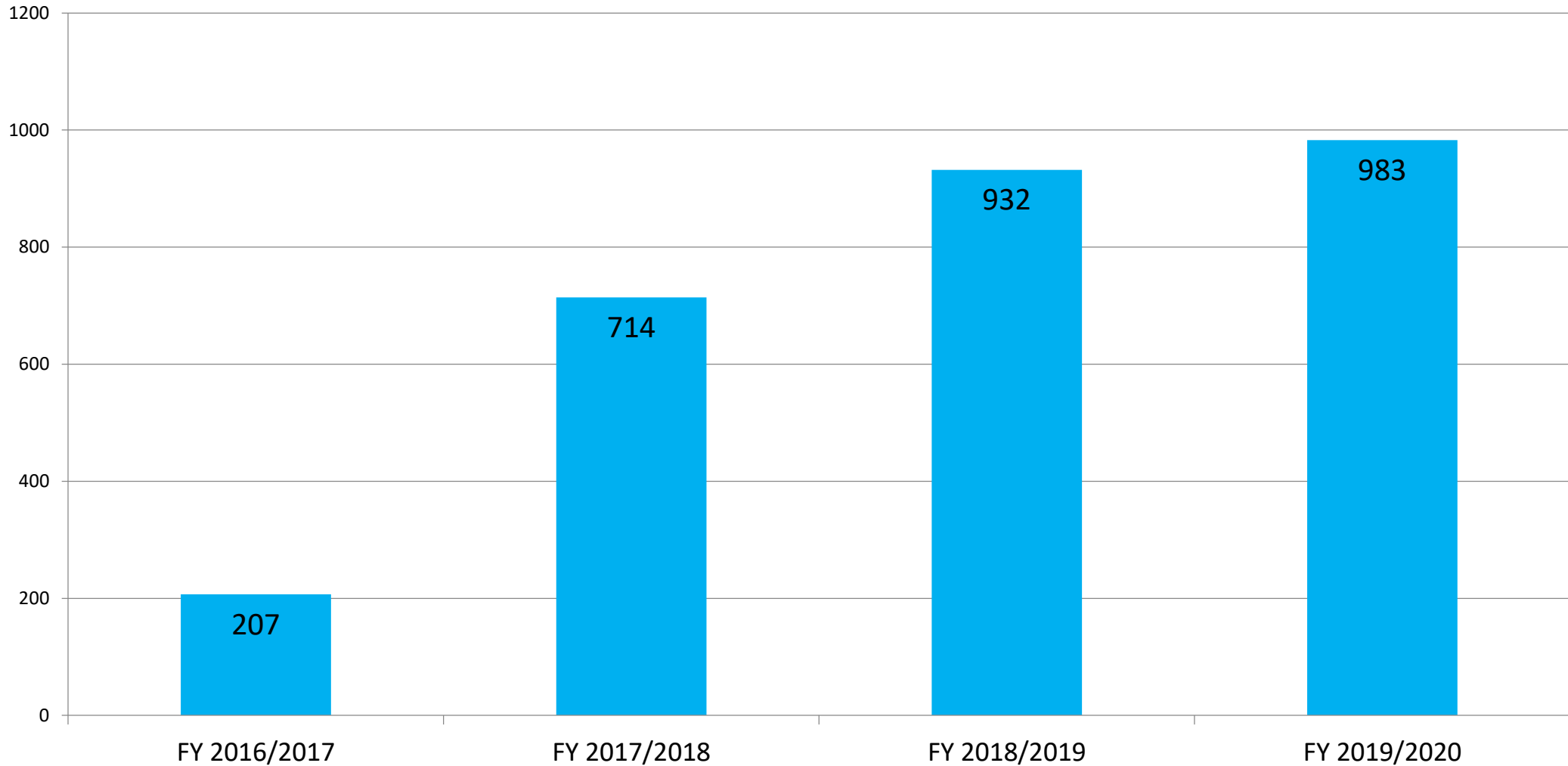
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Hospitalizations



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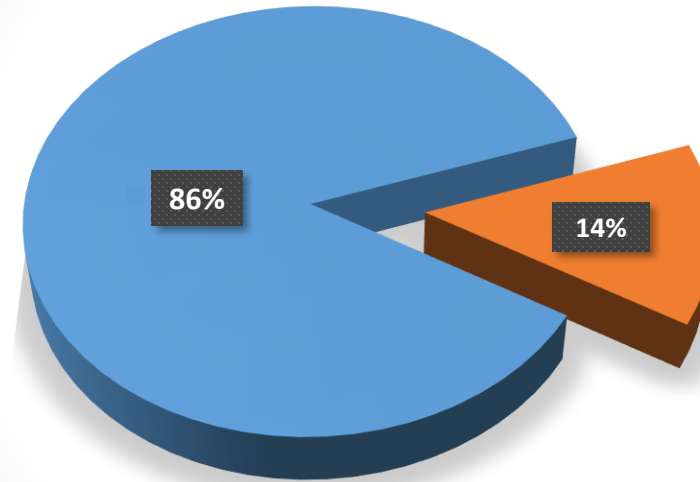
Persons Served in Medication Management Services

■ Decrease In Symptoms

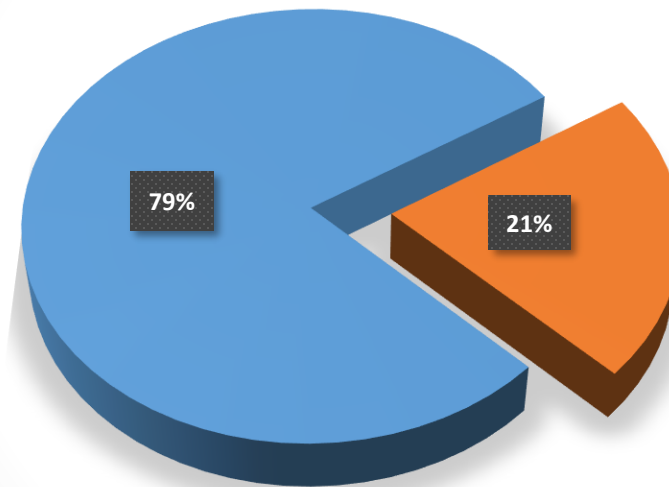
■ Increase In Symptoms

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA)

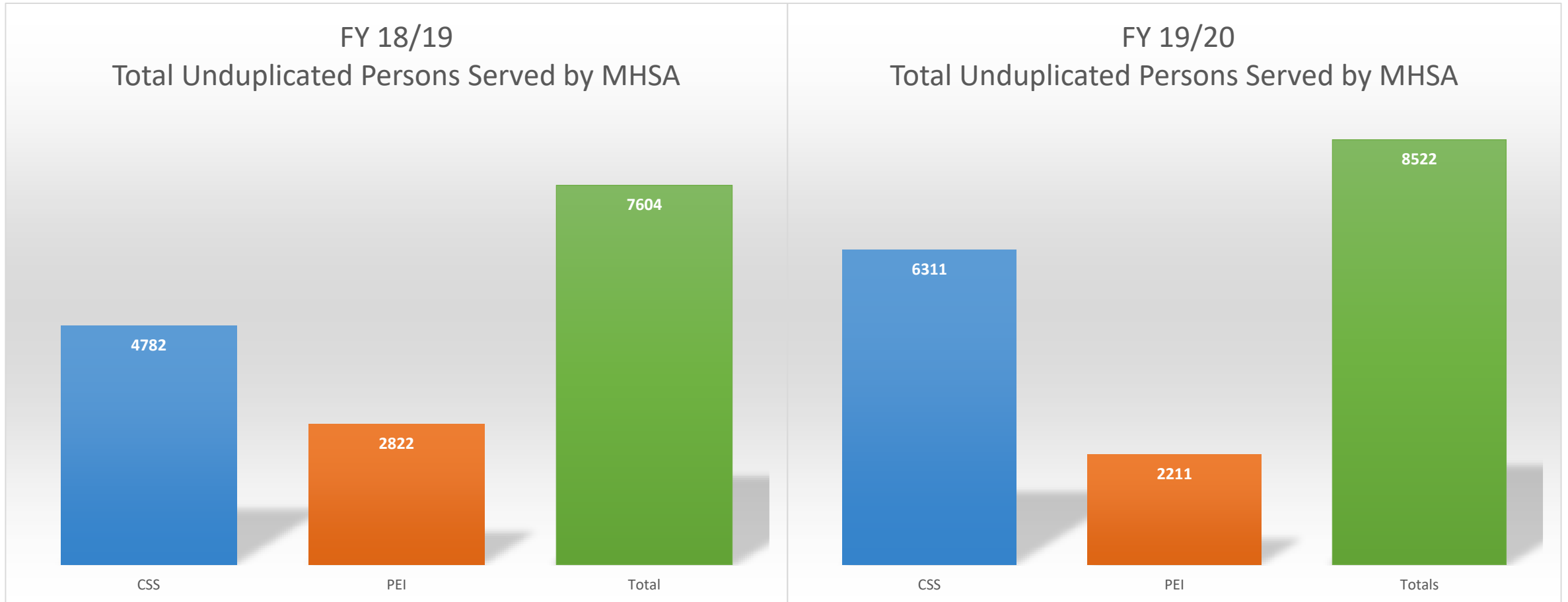
Proposition 63 MHSA

- Provides supportive funding for County Mental Health Programs
- Through a 1% tax on California income in excess of \$1 million dollars
- Funds services and supports in each county that:
 - Promote recovery and wellness for adults
 - Promote resiliency for children and youth

MHSA Funding Supports and Supplements the Specialty Mental Health System

- Community Services and Support Programs
- Prevention and Service Early Intervention Programs
- Innovation Programs
- Full Service Partnership (FSP)
