WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Board of Supervisors to review the salaries and terms and conditions of employment and determine what adjustments, if any, shall be made, and

WHEREAS, effective December 31, 2017, the salary of each Elected Department Head and Elected Official was established at the following levels:

Sheriff	\$153,569
District Attorney	\$153,569

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2013, the elected Department Heads and Elected Officials were de-linked from the Department Head Bargaining Unit; as of December 31, 2017, elected Department Heads and Elected Officials will receive all eligible benefits included in the current Department Head Memorandum of Understanding.
