RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REQUESTING THAT THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT ITS PERMISSION FOR THE CALIFORNIA INDIAN DAYS PARADE IN COVELO, CALIFORNIA, PURSUANT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL'S JOINT POLICY GUIDELINES FOR SPECIAL EVENTS ON STATE CONVENTIONAL HIGHWAY RIGHTS-OF-WAYS

WHEREAS, the Round Valley Indian Tribes are the sovereign Tribal Nation of the Indian Tribes of the Round Valley Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Round Valley Tribal Council is recognized by the Federal Government of the United States of America as the governing body for the Indians of the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Round Valley Indian Tribes authorizes the Round Valley Tribal Council to administer all tribal Business; and

WHEREAS, over the past years the Round Valley Indian Tribes hosts the California Indian Days celebration which is held in September each and every year since it became a recognized holiday; and

WHEREAS, the Round Valley Tribal Council wishes to hold a parade in connection with the California Indian Days celebration; and

WHEREAS, said parade will be held on September 25, 2021 between 9:00 A M. and 12:00 P.M. (line up for the parade and actual parade). Parade line up will commence on Main street and continuing on through Highway 162 through the town of Covelo and ending at Hidden Oaks Park off Highway 162, and

WHEREAS, in order for the parade to be held, the Round Valley Tribal Council needs to seek support from the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to the Department of Transportation and California Highway Patrol's Joint Policy Guidelines for Special Events on State Conventional Highway Rights-of-Ways, to conduct a parade.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors does hereby support the California Indian Days Parade and seeks the support and cooperation of any involved agencies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors does hereby state that any liabilities and responsibilities shall rest with the parade sponsors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors requests the State Department of Transportation to give their permission pursuant to the Department of Transportation and California Highway Patrol's Joint Policy Guidelines for Special Events on State Conventional Rights of Way, for the California Indian Days Parade to be held in Covelo, California, on Highway 162, on September 25, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is directed to forward copies of this Resolution to the Caltrans District Permit Coordinator (Eureka), the California Highway Patrol, and the Round Valley Tribal Council.
