I oppose this resolution.

As written, Jackson Demonstration State Forest (JDSF)Resolution No. 21- can be interpreted as a moratorium on all logging in JDSF pending the "scientific review". As worded, this resolution will terminate urgently needed time sensitive research such as determining the cause of shatter when bear damaged trees are felled.

The information that flows out of JDSF is vital in supporting healthy forests far beyond the boundaries of JDSF. I would suggest that all of you view the pictures of JDSF from 1947 and tour it now before you impose this resolution. You have time. The 2021 logging season has wound down since 11.7 inches of rain has fallen.
