

To the Medocino County Board of Supervisors:

I am writing to urge you to adopt the Resolution requesting scientific review of Jackson Demonstration State Forest, and to urge Governor Newsom and the State's Natural Resources Agency to:

- include any climate impacts of commercial logging on State lands in drawing up the plan to protect 30% of California's land use and coastal waters by 2030
- publish a science-based report that evaluates carbon sequestration capacity and wildfire resiliency of current management practices, as well as alternate management scenarios, of Jackson Demonstration State Forest.

I have been actively working for the preservation of the forests of California for decades, not only for their beauty, but for the environmental impact which removing trees has on our planet. I visit JDSF for recreation.
