Board Directive: GENERAL CONSENSUS OF THE BOARD for Staff to allocate funds as follows to achieve \$2,000,000 in Department of Transportation Corrective Maintenance Fund: Increase RMRA funds from \$215,328 to \$250,000; Decrease Contingencies from \$350,000 to \$250,000 (overriding the current Board of Supervisors policy regarding required contingency amounts); Decrease Pension Gap Reserve contribution from \$1,000,000 to \$850,000 and increase balance balance to \$4.5 million. Further; should there be an additional RMRA fund balance above what was estimated at the First Quarter Budget Report; \$1.2 million will be directed from that balance to the Corrective Maintenance Fund.


