Recommended Action/Motion:

Authorize the issuance of Coastal Development Minor Use Permit, U_2016-0006 (Cimmiyotti), for a Single Unit Rental in the town of Mendocino.

Previous Board/Board Committee Actions:

Adoption of Mendocino County Code Chapter 20 "Zoning", Divisions II (Coastal) and III (Mendocino Town). This code authorizes the Coastal Permit Administrator to administratively approve certain projects without a public hearing, provided that the approval is reported to the Board of Supervisors prior to the permit becoming effective.

Summary of Request:

Coastal Development Minor Use Permit to convert a second floor 956 square-foot commercial retail use into a Single Unit Rental. The Coastal Development Minor Use Permit was administratively approved by the Coastal Permit Administrator (CPA) on January 3, 2017, and requires the Board of Supervisors authorization for

issuance of the permit. The CPA staff report is attached for review.

Any one member of the Board may direct that the Coastal Development Minor Use Permit U_2016-0006 (Cimmiyotti) be scheduled for a public hearing and processed pursuant to Mendocino County Code Section 20.720.045.
