CPT provides psychological rehabilitation programs in a secure residential setting to help transition clients to lower levels of care. Health and Human Services Agency, Behavioral Health and Recovery Services currently has a fee-for-service contract with CPT to cover potential placements. This amendment provides additional funding to ensure mandated residential mental health treatment for a client recently placed in the facility for fiscal year 2018-19.
