The Board regularly approves reimbursement agreements with the State for detection trapping activities. A recent example includes approval of BOS Agreement 23-1155, Cooperative Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture providing reimbursement for Pest Detection trapping activities.

**Summary of Request:**

The CDFA has requested the Board make a designation regarding the local public entity to receive funds allocated by CDFA for work done related to Pierce's Disease and its vectors, and other designated pests and diseases. For the 2024 contract, reimbursable work related to this program can bring in up to \$18,546.85 to

the Ag Department.
