Adopt Resolution approving and adopting an addendum to the previously adopted Mitigated Negative Declaration, in compliance with California Environmental Quality Act Requirements, for amendments to Chapter 10A.17 Mendocino Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance and Chapter 20.242 Cannabis Cultivation Sites of the Mendocino County Code; adding Chapter 20.118 "CA" Cannabis Accommodation Combining District and Chapter 20.119 "CP" Commercial Cannabis Prohibition Combining District to the Mendocino County Code; and rezoning certain parcels to apply the CA and CP Combining Districts and authorize Chair to sign same; and Introduce and waive first reading of an Ordinance amending Chapter 10A.17 Mendocino Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance and Chapter 20.242 Cannabis Cultivation Sites of the Mendocino County Code; adding Chapter 20.118 "CA" Cannabis Accommodation Combining District and Chapter 20.119 "CP" Commercial Cannabis Prohibition Combining District to the Mendocino County Code; and Rezoning Certain Parcels to Apply the CA and CP Combining Districts.

Previous Board/Board Committee Actions:

On October 3, 2017 the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors entered into an agreement with planning consulting firm Michael Baker International to develop a zoning exemption process (overlay) for cannabis cultivation sites. The Board received presentations by Michael Baker International at their January 23, 2018 and June 12, 2018 meetings and gave direction at those times. The Planning Commission reviewed the

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proposed ordinances and amendments at their meeting of October 18, 2018, and recommended that the proposed changes and new ordinances be adopted by the Board of Supervisors, with modifications and suggestions as specified in the Commission's resolution.
