Summary of Request:

Mendocino County Department of Social Services, Special Investigations Unit (SIU), issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) No. RFP-046-22 for security guard services on June 17, 2022. SIU selected Armorous Private Security (Armorous) as the top ranked vendor to contract with Social Services for security guard services. The proposed Agreement with Armorous in the amount of \$192,691.20, is the third consecutive year of security guard services from Armorous under RFP-046-22.

Pursuant to the proposed Agreement, Armorous will continue to provide three (3) uniformed and supervised Security Guards for forty hours per week at each of the following Social Services sites:

- Yokayo Social Services Campus (727/737/747 South State Street, Ukiah)
- Fort Bragg Avila Center (764/790 South Franklin Street, Fort Bragg)
- Willits Integrated Services Center, (WISC) (472 East Valley Street, Willits)
