Summary of Request:

Health and Human Services Agency, California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Job Services provides employment and training services to recipients and applicants of the Temporary Assistance File #: 20-0532, Version: 1

for Needy Families program (TANF). The TANF program is a federally funded program that promotes job preparation and employment for families to become self-sufficient. CalWORKs Job Services provides funding for job development services as part of a broader commitment to families in need.

CalWORKs Job Services has been partnering with, and co-located with, Employment Development Department (EDD) since 1996. The proposed Agreement with EDD allows EDD staff to be available to provide direct placement and/or individualized job development services in order to support CalWORKs Job Services participants who are transitioning to self-sufficiency. Services associated with this contract include assessment of each participant's employment goals and assistance with expanding job services by linking transferrable skills to broader occupational and industrial categories.
