# <u>Summary of Request:</u>

On November 30, 2020, Mendocino County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) submitted an

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application for funds from the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) for Building Workforce Capacity of Rural/Frontier Local Health Departments to Respond to COVID-19. On July 1, 2021, HHSA was notified of available funds from NACCHO and asked to execute the resulting revenue Agreement for Building Rural Workforce Capacity, Training and Technical Assistance (TTA) services. These funds enable the County to address challenges faced with achieving adequate personnel to address the COVID-19 pandemic, and provides training and technical assistance on best practices with a focus on vaccine administration.

HHSA staff received the request from NACCHO to execute this revenue agreement on July 1, 2021, with an already retroactive start date of February 5, 2021. HHSA now requests approval of this retroactive revenue Agreement.
