<u>Summary of Request:</u>

The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) works with local law enforcement agencies regarding illicit cannabis eradication activities on Federal lands within their jurisdiction. The funds are used to defray costs relating to the eradication and suppression of illicit cannabis. They are

primarily intended for payment of deputies' overtime while those deputies are directly engaged in the illicit cannabis eradication process. The agreement runs from January 1, 2016, to September 30, 2016. The Department requests five (5) original Agreements for processing with the U.S. Department of Justice.
