Discussion and Possible Direction to Staff Regarding a Draft Medical Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance, Draft Medical Cannabis Cultivation Site Zoning Regulation and Commencing a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Project Description and Initial Study (*Sponsor: General Government Committee*)

Recommended Action/Motion:

Provide direction to Staff regarding a draft Medical Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance, draft Medical Cannabis Cultivation Site Zoning Regulation and commencing a CEQA project description and initial study.

Previous Board/Board Committee Actions:

March 15, April 18 and May 16, 2016, the Marijuana Ad Hoc brought forward recommendations regarding the development of a permanent medical marijuana cultivation ordinance; May 17, 2016, Board adopted a medical marijuana cultivation urgency ordinance and directed staff to bring back an item to disband the Marijuana Ad Hoc and refer the development of a permanent ordinance to the General Government Standing Committee;

June 7, 2016, Board disbanded the Marijuana Ad Hoc and referred the development of a permanent marijuana cultivation ordinance to the General Government Standing Committee; June 20, 2016, the General Government Standing Committee provided direction to staff regarding change to the draft medical cannabis cultivation ordinance and zoning regulation; July 8, 2016, the General Government Standing Committee provided direction to staff regarding changes to the draft medical cannabis cultivation ordinance and zoning regulation and recommendation for full Board review prior to commencing the CEQA project description and initial study process.

Summary of Request:

Staff from the Department of Agriculture, Planning and Building, County Counsel and Executive Office have reviewed the recommendations from the Board of Supervisors May 16, 2016, meeting and General Government Standing Committee meetings on June 20, 2016 and July 8, 2016 and modified the draft Medical Cannabis Cultivation Compliance Program and a Medical Cannabis Cultivation Site Zoning Regulation for your consideration.

Additional information resulting from the July 8, 2016, standing committee meeting will be distributed the Board and the public prior to the Board of Supervisors July 12, 2016, meeting. Included in the Board's packet are the items presented to the General Government Standing Committee meeting on July 8, 2016. Staff will present an overview of the cultivation ordinance, site zoning regulation and recommendations from the Standing Committee. The Standing Committee requests the Board's consideration and feedback on the cultivation ordinance and zoning regulation. Following feedback, the Standing Committee recommends the Board direct staff to commence the CEQA project description and initial study process.
