Previous Board/Board Committee Actions:

The Board of Supervisors has approved the parade every year since 1986. The last action was on August 18, 2015.

Summary of Request:

Representatives of the Mendocino County Fair and Apple Show are requesting permission to hold a parade on Sunday, September 18, 2016 in Boonville. Said parade would be held between 12:00 p.m. and 1:30 p.m., commencing on Manchester Road and proceeding along Highway 128 to the Fairgrounds. Cooperation will be

given to the California Highway Patrol and to the Mendocino County Sheriff's Department in allowing traffic to proceed on the highway, as only one lane is needed to conduct said parade. In order for the parade to be held, the Mendocino County Fair and Apple Show is seeking permission from the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to the Department of Transportation and California Highway Patrol's Joint Policy Guidelines for Special Events on State Conventional Highway Rights-of-Ways.
