Summary of Request:

The Emergency Management Performance Grant is pass-through funding from the Federal Emergency

Management Agency (Homeland Security) to the State of California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) and down to the individual Operational Areas. This year's EMPG allocation for Mendocino County is \$143,435 and requires a dollar for dollar (100%) local match of funds. Funding is used to support activities that contribute to Mendocino County's capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to and recover from emergencies and disasters, whether natural or man-made. The grant requires a certified copy of the Board of Supervisors Resolution appointing agents authored to execute any actions necessary under this Grant with the Emergency Management Performance Grant application
