Adoption of Mendocino County Code Chapter 20 "Zoning", Divisions II (Coastal). This code authorizes the Coastal Permit Administrator to administratively approve certain projects without a public hearing, provided that the approval is reported to the Board of Supervisors prior to the permit becoming effective.

Summary of Request:

Coastal Development Permit to construct a single family residence and associated improvements. The Coastal Development Permit was administratively approved by the Coastal Permit Administrator (CPA) on February 9, 2017 and requires the Board of Supervisors authorization for issuance of the permit.
