Summary of Request:

On June 13, 2017, the Governing Board of the Mendocino Fire Protection District ("District") adopted a resolution requesting the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors ("Board") to approve consolidation of the District's election of their governing board with the statewide General Election in November of each even-numbered year. The Board received notice of this resolution on June 22, 2017, through the County Executive Office. In accord with Elections Code section 10404.5(d)(1), the Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters provided an impact analysis. Section 10404.5(d)(1) requires the Board to approve the District's resolution unless it finds
