Summary of Request:

California Department of Social Services (CDSS) has been providing adoption services for foster children involved with the Health and Human Services Agency, Family and Children's Services for over 17 years. This is

the sixth fiscal year since 2011 Realignment that counties have had the option to provide their own adoption services through county child welfare services departments or to contract the allocation back to CDSS for continued services. At this point in time, CDSS continues to be in a better position than the county to provide adoption services.
