direct service support primarily for social workers, eligibility workers, and support staff working within the community. Some of the trainings will provide education to staff in service areas that cross multiple programs, e.g., the Affordable Care Act, which crosses both EFAS (Employment Family and Assistance Services) and AS (Adult and Aging Services), and eligibility factors for Approved Relative Caregivers, which cross EFAS and FCS (Family and Children's Services).
