Summary of Request:

The State Homeland Security Grant is pass-through funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency

File #: 17-0950, Version: 1

(FEMA) to the State of California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) and down to the individual Operational Areas. Funding is used to support activities that contribute to Mendocino County's capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to and recover from emergencies and disasters. Traditionally these funds have been used to fund EMS, Fire, HazMat and law enforcement training, exercises and equipment. The grant requires a certified copy of the Board of Supervisors Resolution appointing agents authorized to execute any actions necessary under this Grant with the State Homeland Security Grant application.
