Recommended Action/Motion:

Adopt Urgency Ordinance prohibiting price gouging following the Redwood Complex Fire; and authorize Chair to sign same.

Previous Board/Board Committee Actions:

On October 17, 2017, the Board gave direction to draft an Urgency Ordinance regarding price gauging.

Summary of Request:

On October 13, 2017, the Mendocino County Health Officer declared a local health emergency which was ratified by the Board of Supervisors on October 17, 2017. An ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, which contains a declaration of the facts constituting the urgency, and is passed by a four-fifths vote of the board of supervisors, shall take effect immediately. Government Code section 25131

specifies that an urgency ordinance may be passed immediately upon introduction.

At the direction of the Board of Supervisors, County staff has prepared an ordinance that prohibits price gouging following the Redwood Complex Fire and increases the penalties for violating the ordinance.
