Summary of Request:

Mendocino County has been contracting with local non-profit agencies to provide emergency shelter services for County indigents since 1982. Redwood Community Services (RCS) has worked throughout the County on issues related to housing and homelessness, case-management, referral services, and individual supports. Under this Agreement, RCS will set up and maintain the Inland Valley Emergency Winter Shelter to provide temporary shelter between November 7, 2017, and April 15, 2018, to individuals at-risk of or currently

experiencing homelessness.
