Previous Board/Board Committee Actions:

The Board of Supervisors approved the original agreement on September 8, 2015. The first amendment was approved by the Department on June 9, 2016.

Summary of Request:

Foundations is an early intervention and prevention program that provides direct services to juveniles with low-level drug and alcohol related offenses. The program consists of a 10-week series of classes, and is a collaborative effort between MCYP, the Probation Department, Mendocino County Office of Education, Project

Sanctuary, and AODP. Cost: \$70,000.00.

Dual-Diagnosis Counseling provides services to youth suffering from both mental health and substance abuse problems. Services are provided on an outpatient basis, and may be continued for youth remanded to Juvenile Hall. Cost: \$25,000.00.
