Adoption of Resolution Declaring the Continuation of a Local Emergency Related To the Redwood Complex Fire

Recommended Action/Motion:

Adopt Resolution declaring the continuation of a Local Emergency related to the Redwood Complex Fire; and authorize Chair to sign same.

Previous Board/Board Committee Actions:

On October 10, 2017, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 17-147, declaring an emergency related to the Redwood Complex Fire. On October 31, 2017, the Board adopted Resolution 17-153, declaring a continuation of the Local Emergency.

Summary of Request:

On October 9, 2017, the Redwood Fire started and has resulted in significant structural damage to several portions of the County. On October 9, 2017, the Mendocino County Chief Executive Officer/Director of Emergency services proclaimed, by delegation, that a state of emergency exists. On October 10, 2017, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 17-147, declaring an emergency related to the Redwood Complex Fire. On October 31, 2017, the Board adopted Resolution 17-153 declaring a continuation of the Local Emergency.

Pursuant to MCC Section 7.04.090(3), the Board of Supervisors shall review, at its regularly scheduled meetings until the local emergency is terminated, the need for continuing the local emergency. However in no event shall a review take place more than thirty (30) days after the previous review. It is proposed that at its meeting on November 14, 2017, the Board of Supervisors adopt a Resolution declaring the continuation of the local emergency.
