The Proclamation recognizes the traumatic intrusion of crime on crime victims' lives and the need to protect the rights of crime victims. The Proclamation acknowledges the necessity for the existence of Crime Victims' Assistance Programs. The Mendocino County District Attorney's Victim Witness Assistance Program

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provides victims' services to crime victims throughout the County of Mendocino.
