Summary of Request:

Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), Employment and Family Assistance Services (EFAS) is responsible for administering the CalWORKs, Welfare to Work (WtW), CalFresh and Medi-Cal programs for the County. In an effort to meet mandated performance standards, HHSA must have a reliable system to effectively monitor mandated program requirements, including timely processing of status reports,

redetermination of eligibility, and various other caseload activities related to administration of the programs. The use of Exemplar's reports and services will provide EFAS staff with the necessary tools to effectively monitor performance and outcomes, assist in meeting current State and Federal standards and will help to better serve our community with shortened processing times.
