Summary of Request:

Mendocino County has been contracting with local non-profit agencies for emergency shelter services for Mendocino County indigents since 1982. Mendocino Coast Hospitality Center provides an emergency shelter

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and operates a resource center in Fort Bragg to address the needs of the Health and Human Services Agency's General Assistance clients and other members of the coastal region population who are at risk of or currently experiencing homelessness.
