The California Department of Social Services Office of Child Abuse Prevention (OCAP) provides funding for Child Abuse Prevention programs through multiple Federal and State funding sources. The services provided with these funds must tie into the County's Child Welfare System Improvement Plan (SIP). The non-profit

Family Resource Center Network has provided these services countywide since 2011 when the most recent Request for Proposal (RFP) was completed. This proposed contract will ensure OCAP services continue in the community to prevent and target child abuse and neglect in FY 2018-19.
