Summary of Request:

The Human Resources Department is charged, as part of the overall maintenance of the classification and compensation plan, to evaluate current classifications, create new classifications (including appropriate salary levels), reclassify positions, examine request for salary grade adjustments, analyze allocations, and make recommendations for additions, modifications, and corrections.

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The title change aligns with the terminology used by the State in the field of substance abuse, and better defines the role within HHSA's Behavioral Health and Recovery Services.

The Civil Service Commission approved the title change at its November 18, 2015 meeting. The Health and Human Services Agency recently requested to fill the position and this request, if approved, will amend the position allocation table to reflect the appropriate classification title.
