Health and Human Services Agency, Public Health Branch submitted the State of California-Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) grant application for Board approval on January 23, 2018. Public Health received the grant Agreement on September 25, 2018, but because OTS both lowered the amount from \$300,000 to \$150,000 and removed the services to be provided by Public Health, Health and Human Services is now resubmitting this item for Board approval.
