Summary of Request:

Clarification was needed in order to better understand the cannabis cultivation charts for "legacy" and "non-legacy" sites.

The ad hoc committee is making these recommendations:

- 1. Have an open window for new legacy cultivator permits which would be for six months after adoption/implementation of the cannabis equity program.
- 2. Adopt zoning and scale charts for both "legacy" and "non-legacy" cultivation site permits.
