Approval of Revenue Amendment No. 19-10160 A01 with the California Department of Public Health in the Amount of \$49,950 for a New Total of \$2,911,554 for Women, Infants and Children Program Services, Effective October 1, 2019 Through September 30, 2022; Adoption of Resolution Approving Execution of the Amendment, and Authorizing the Health and Human Services Agency Director or Designee to Sign Future Amendments that do not Exceed the Maximum Amount

Recommended Action/Motion:

Approve revenue Amendment No. 19-10160 A01 with the California Department of Public Health in the amount of \$49,950 for a new total of \$2,911,554 for Women, Infants and Children program services, effective October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022; adopt Resolution approving the execution of the Amendment, and authorizing the Health and Human Services Agency Director or designee to sign future amendments that do not exceed the maximum amount; and authorize Chair to sign same.

Summary of Request:

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) provides funds to the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) program of the Health and Human Services Agency, Public Health Branch, to support pregnant, breastfeeding, or postpartum women and their children. These funds enable the WIC program to provide services to help mothers and young children stay healthy. Qualifying WIC participants are eligible to receive nutrition education, vouchers for nutritious food, breastfeeding support, and referrals to medical providers and community services. WIC currently provides these supportive services at nine locations throughout the County.

The original amount of revenue Agreement No. 19-10160 was \$2,861,604. The proposed amendment increases the Agreement by \$49,950 for Fiscal Year 1, which brings the total of the Agreement to \$2,911,554. The increased funding for Fiscal Year 1 will support the County's needs for actual expenses invoiced for the Families First Coronavirus Response Act.
