Summary of Request:

In Mendocino County the demand for Nuestra Alianza de Willits to continue to oversee a Promotores de Salud demonstration program that trains and prepares culturally responsive Spanish speaking community health workers, also known as promotoras or promotores, to support health education and prevention efforts in Mendocino County's COVID-19 response in order to reduce the disproportionate impact of the COVID-19 virus on the Hispanic/Latinx population continues to be a need. Funds are being used to develop, train, document and evaluate an Ambassador of Health Promotion Pilot Program that strengthens various outreach and engagement efforts in Mendocino County. The anticipated long-term outcome of the project is a reduced rate of COVID-19 spread in Mendocino County.
