Approve Agreement with Mendocino Coast Hospitality Center in the amount of \$50,571 to provide intensive care management and development of integrated individual service plans to support the Finding Home Grant, effective September 30, 2021 through September 29, 2022; authorize the Behavioral Health Director or designee to sign any future amendments that do not exceed the annual maximum amount; and authorize Chair to sign same.

Previous Board/Board Committee Actions:

Ongoing agreement since 2017; last action on January 26, 2021, Item 4(t), BOS Agreement 21-008.

Summary of Request:

In 2017, the Health and Human Services Agency applied for and received Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) funding for the Finding Home Project. The Project's goal is to decrease homelessness and improve the health, well-being and self-sufficiency of persons who are experiencing homelessness and have co-occurring disorders (mental illness and substance use disorders).

Using SAMHSA Finding Home Grant funds, Mendocino Coast Hospitality Center (MCHC) provides services for individuals experiencing homelessness in Mendocino County, and supports recovery through integrated Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder treatment. Such services include: intensive care management and coordinated development of integrated individual service plans; integrated Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder treatment; intensive care management, including access to primary health care and wrap around support; and access to permanent housing. This contract is for the 5th year of a 5 year grant.
