On October 18, 2016, the Board of Supervisors reviewed the revised Draft Medical Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance (10A.17), Draft Medical Cannabis Cultivation Site Zoning Regulation (20.242), California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Project Description and Initial Study. On December 1, 2016, the Mendocino County Planning Commission held a public workshop for community input.
