Approval of Retroactive Agreement with Willow Glen Care Center in the Amount of \$1,000,000 to Provide Residential Treatment Services for Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (BHRS) Adult Clients for the Term of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018

Approve retroactive Agreement with Willow Glen Care Center in the amount of \$1,000,000 to provide residential treatment services for BHRS adult clients for term of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018; authorize the Health and Human Services Agency Director or designee to sign any future amendments to the Agreement that do not increase the annual maximum amount; and authorize Chair to sign same.

## Summary of Request:

Willow Glen Care Center provides coordinated residential care and specialized programs in a safe and supportive environment. Willow Glen offers a board range of services to adults requiring a structured environment due to mental health challenges. Services include group therapy, trainings, entertainment/recreation, transportation and programs to promote the recovery of clients for independent living in the community. The County's goal is to transfer clients to a less restrictive residential setting as soon as they are medically able. Basic daily rates vary depending on the level of care.
