Summary of Request:

Annually, the Elk Volunteer Fire Department organizes a parade on Highway 1 through Elk, preceding the "Great Day in Elk" town fair and fundraising event for the Elk Community Center. In order to obtain a permit from CalTrans for the parade, a letter of support is required from the California Highway Patrol and Sheriff, along with a Resolution from the Board of Supervisors and a certificate of insurance from the Elk Volunteer Fire Department's insurance carrier, pursuant to Caltrans/California Highway Patrol's Joint Policy Guidelines for Special Events on State Conventional Highways.
